



CODE OF CONDUCT –BRAUNSTONE LEISURE CENTRE

Any person/persons found to be vandalising the facility will be reported to the Police and removed from the Centre.

Any person/persons found to be hanging from Changing Room doors will be removed from the Centre.

Any person/persons deliberately found to be blocking the toilets will be removed from the Centre.

Any swimmers in swimsuits observed climbing over the Spectator Poolside Barriers will be removed from the Centre.

Any member of the public found to be verbally or physically aggressive to Centre Staff will be removed from the Centre

All swimmers must wear Poolside shoes when leaving the Poolside

A Lifeguard will patrol the Changing Area at all times during the Galas to ensure swimmers are adhering to the Conduct of Conduct and will report any bad behaviour.

The Community pool when not needed must only be used for the warm up swims.

No food is allowed anywhere on the actual poolside, this includes sweets and chewing gum.

Swimmers must only change in the village changing rooms, the dry side changing area must not be used.
