



CODE OF CONDUCT 2022/23

Any person/s found to be vandalizing the facility used for any event organized by Leicestershire & Rutland ASA will be reported to the organizer and may be requested to leave the location.

Any person/s found to be misbehaving and or bringing our sport into disrepute in the Changing Room areas may be requested to leave the location.

Any swimmers in swimsuits observed climbing over any Spectator Poolside Barriers may be requested to leave the location. All swimmers must wear poolside shoes and club outerwear at least when leaving the poolside. Swimmers must change in the wet changing room areas only.

Any person/s found to be verbally or physically aggressive to Staff employed at the facility or any Official or Volunteer assisting with the event may be requested to leave the location.

A Leisure Centre Lifeguard will patrol the Changing Areas at all times during the Galas to ensure swimmers are adhering to the Conduct of Conduct and will report any bad behavior.

The Community pool, where available must only be used for the warm up/cool down swims.

No food or hot drinks are allowed anywhere on the poolside. Unless there is a medical reason, for non adherence, which is to be made known to Leisure Centre and Promoter of event in advance.

All personal phones & tablets are not allowed for video or photo imaging use in any area of the leisure center's poolside and changing areas (see Leisure Centers rules for each venue on LASA entry information) and may only be used on poolside/changing areas for private personal use of games and music. The support of poolside personnel from each club are expected to assist in this happening.

The Promoter reserves the right to align our Code of Conduct in line with whatever the current Covid-19 rules are in place at the time.

Any person/s or clubs who place images of swimmers on their social media sites are responsible for any resultant complaint/litigation resulting from their action/s. LASA cannot police what Facebook and Twitter and other Social Media sites themselves cannot control.

LASA is permitting photography of presentations only and it is up to the club to remove any person who needs not to be photographed.
