## **Event Conditions**

#### **General Conditions**

- 1. The promoter of the meet is Leicestershire and Rutland ASA
- 2. All competitors must be a "Club Compete" (Category 2) member or equivalent of Swim England/Scottish Swimming/Swim Wales at the time of entry
- 3. All competitors, including those who are swimming in relay teams, must be entered on the meet database in the name of the club they wish to represent by the closing date for individual entries
- 4. Entries must be made on the online entry system and must be completed via PayPal to secure entry.
- 5. No Refunds will be considered unless supported by Doctors certificate
- 6. Swimmers must represent the same club for both individual entries and relays
- Age is at the 31<sup>st</sup> December in the year of competition. All competitors must be 18 or over on the day of competition
- 8. Age groups will be 18-24, 25-29 and in 5 year age bands as necessary, there is no upper age limit
- 9. Team relay age groups will be 72+, 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+
  - For the teams 120+ and up is the combined members ages at midnight on 31 December in the year of competition must fall within the age band given with the proviso that all team members must be 25 years of age or older on the 31 December in the year of competition
  - For the 72+ team the combined ages at midnight on 31 December in the year of competition, with all team members being aged 18 years or over on the first day of the Championships.
- 10. The mixed teams shall consist of two competitors of each sex swimming in any order
- 11. Relay declaration forms must be handed to the recorders 30 minutes prior to the start of the relevant session.
- 12. Competitors taking part in relay events MUST have entered an Individual event at this Meet.
- 13. Entries without an entry time will be allocated in the first heats. Relays will be seeded by age bands, using the minimum number of heats
- 14. If the Meet is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a "**first-come, first-served**" basis, with restricted numbers in some events in order to control the overall meet time.
- 15. Overhead starts may be used at the Promoter's discretion
- 16. Anything not covered in these conditions will be at the discretion of the promoter

#### Awards

- 17. A Prize will be made to the top 3 Open/male and female swimmers achieving the most points in each Age Group.
- Medals will be awarded to the to the 1<sup>st</sup> placed team in the relay events, within the given age groups
- 19. The top team trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring team based on swimmers and relay teams being allocated points 6-1 for  $1st 6^{th}$  within each age group throughout the meet

## Leicestershire County Masters Championships

We are delighted that the LASA Open meet will also act as the Leicestershire County Masters Championships.

- Open to all swimmers who are members of, and are competing for, clubs affiliated to Leicestershire & Rutland ASA, and who have not in the calendar year, swum for another county or participated in another counties closed Masters Championships
- 2. The above promoters conditions apply
- 3. Medals to be awarded to the first swimmer in each age group, 18-24 upwards
- 4. The Leicestershire swimmers will be integrated, and take part in the Open meet and will be eligible for awards as an Open meet swimmer

Please be aware the rules of the Inter-County Masters events do not allow you to compete for another county once you have swum in the same year in an event for another county, therefore if you enter Leicestershire & Rutland championships you will only be eligible to compete only for Leicestershire & Rutland in inter-county events during the 2023/24 swimming calendar year.
